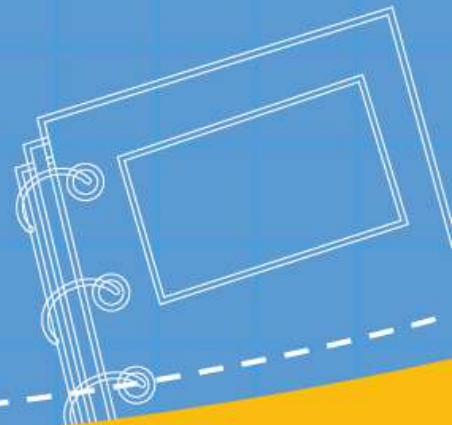

Uses

We use it to talk about something that is happening at the moment in which we are speaking.

(Lo usamos para hablar de algo que está pasando en el momento que estamos hablando)



▶ Lisa is going to the mall right now.

▶ They are having breakfast at the moment.

Uses

We can also use it to talk about something that is happening now, but not necessarily at the moment we are speaking.

(Lo usamos para hablar de algo que está pasando en la actualidad pero no necesariamente en el momento que estamos hablando).

- ▶ I am studying Architecture.
- ▶ He is teaching in a private school.



Uses

The present continuous is also used to talk about definite plans a near future.

(Lo usamos para hablar de planes definidos para un futuro próximo).

- ▶ *We are going to the movies this weekend.*
- ▶ *She is traveling next Wednesday.*



Grammatical rules

Affirmative sentences:

Subject + auxiliary verb(verb be) + main verb with -ing

Example:

▶ She is running in the park right now.

Negative sentences:

Subject + auxiliary verb(verb be) + not + main verb with -ing

Example:

▶ They aren't studying at the moment.

Grammatical rules

Y/N Questions:

Auxiliary verb (verb be) + Subject + main verb with -ing

Example:

▶ Are you playing soccer?

Yes, I am / No, I am not

▶ Is his father driving?

Yes, he is / No, he is not
